Johnson County Friends Feeding Friends receives a \$2500 grant from the Rocky Mountain Power Foundation.

JC-FFF has been providing food assistance to kids in Johnson County since 2018. They send home over 150 weekend food bags weekly, as well as provide fresh fruit and snacks to the five participating school pantries. Friends Feeding Friends is also helping to provide shelf stable food for our local community mini-pantries, located in Buffalo and Kaycee, Wyoming.

"We are so grateful for the Rocky Mountain Power Foundation," said Sharon Miller, Program Coordinator for JC-FFF. "Increased food costs at the grocery stores are affecting the people in our community. We are seeing our bag numbers increase weekly. This grant money is such a gift to our program. It will help to ensure that we have the funds necessary to meet the increasing demand."
